This site turns vintage games into a free massively multiplayer online (MMO) browser games. It quickly became the main focus of Theorybee, Inc. So while I attempt to reclaim the deposit the developer stole from my company, I am pursuing a more viable technical solution to this venture.

Additionally, I released a song on iTunes under the moniker of Eszosoft. My latest song, "I Need to Think," will hit the iTunes store sometime in early 2014. I have had success in music creation in the past, particularly within the classical music genre, but Deadmau5 won me over to electronic. So I ended up making some songs in FL Studio 10 and Garageband.

I also completed all of the things that I named in the 2013 letter. Promoting awareness with bloggers and other websites was not too successful, but we did succeed in receiving a little bit of recognition here and there. I did publish an article, which was titled "Yours Is a Great Presentation". It featured a PowerPoint that I made, giving suggestions and advice on how to be a better speaker. It was mildly successful, but didn't seem to generate any activity within THEORYbee, which was the underlining goal.

I then started writing a novel on Wattpad, titled *Kargon*. It is a rather unique story, and I intend to write three novels in the current saga. My eventual goal is to publish it via Smashwords or a local publisher.

The corporation itself it still in its infant stages, but I am expanding its reach, slowly but surely. So far, Theorybee, Inc. is involved in education/innovation (THEORYbee), gaming (Multi2D), music (Eszosoft), and writing (Kargon). This is about as far as I plan on expanding for now, until Theorybee, Inc. grows enough to expand even more.
